COVID-19 Specific

Aims of Northfield Primary and Nursery School

“Our mission is to develop children mentally, spiritually and physically in preparation for the experiences, opportunities and responsibilities of life.”

The school will:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection.
- Encourage children to follow the social distancing rules as set out by the Government.
- Ensure each child is assigned to a specific ‘bubble’ for learning with the same Teacher and TA where possible.
- Provide each child with their own individual work station and resources.
- Stagger drop off and pick up times to ensure a minimal amount of people outside school at one time.
- Stagger playtimes or ensure areas are segregated to ensure a minimal number of children in the playground at one time.
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child’s well-being, mental health and academic needs.
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19.
- Inform you if staff or children in your child’s ‘bubble’ show symptoms of Covid-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative.

Parents/ carers will:

- Adhere to the social distancing rules outside school when dropping off and picking up.
- Talk to their child about the necessity for social distancing, importance of regular hand washing and the necessity to use their elbow or a tissue when coughing or sneezing (catch it-bin it-kill it).
- Only send to school, their child’s water bottle and packed lunch (where necessary). The water bottle will be washed thoroughly before bringing back to school the next day.
- Ensure that their child has a shower/bath and their clothes are washed when returning home.
- Not send their child to school if they, or anyone in the household, shows symptoms of COVID-19 and will self-isolate for 14 days. If they get tested, they will let school know the result.
- Collect their child from school immediately if their child, or another child in their ‘bubble’ develops symptoms of COVID-19.
- Ensure that all contact phone numbers and email addresses are up-to-date and that they can be reached throughout the school day

Pupils will:

- Try to follow social distancing rules in the classroom and playground.
- Only use the equipment/resources given to them by their Teacher/TA.
- Follow good hand hygiene by washing their hands after using the toilet and when asked by an adult.
- Use their elbow or a tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it) if they need to cough or sneeze.
- Tell an adult at school if they feel unwell.
