Are you entitled to Free School Meals & Milk?



You may qualify for Free School Meals and Milk if you receive one of the following benefits:

- **Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)**
- **Income Support**
- **Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance**
- **Income-related Employment Support Allowance**
- **Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**
- **Guarantee element of State Pension Credit**
- **Child Tax Credit (provided not entitled to working tax credit) and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190.**
- **Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.**
- **Universal Credit**

Please ensure that you apply for Free School Meals if you think you might be entitled, even if you don't intend your child to have the meal. We receive **extra funding of £1,320** for each child registered. If you think you are eligible please apply ASAP.

Please Note – All children in F2, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to the Government Funded Universal Free School Meals.

If you think you may also be entitled to Income Related Free School Meals (as above), please also apply as school will receive much needed extra funding.
